HOTSPOT FAQ

- How do I create a Wi-Fi Hotspot ? Directions can be found with the device.
- What happens when a Hotspot becomes overdue? Service to an overdue Hotspot is disabled, meaning the device cannot produce a Wi-Fi signal.
- How many devices can connect to the Hotspot? Ten devices can connect to the Hotspot at a time.
- Does the Hotspot have a data cap? No! Hotspots have unlimited data.
- Does the library see what I used the Hotspot for?
 No. The library does not see what devices connected to the Hotspot or how the Wi-Fi was used.
- TIP: We recommend forgetting the Hotspot network on your devices when you are done using the Hotspot and are returning it to the library.
- Who should I call if there is a technical problem? Please call the Osterhout Free Library Central Branch and inform a staff member of the problem in as much detail as possible. If the library cannot troubleshoot the issue, the device and/or service provider will be contacted.
